Nickel carbonate, anhydrous (CAS No. 3333-67-3), or nickel carbonate, hydroxide complex (CAS No. 12244-51-8) (provided for in subheading 2836.99.50).

Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:

Nickel carbonate is produced from nickel metal or nickel metal intermediates. It is used as an ingredient in the production of catalysts designed to remove polluting agents like nitrogen from petro fuels (diesel and gasoline) and petroleum intermediates. Nickel carbonate is also used in the production of colored glass, nickel pigments, and as a neutralizing compound in nickel electroplating solutions. The subject product is imported from Finland, the Philippines, China, and France.
