- 3 SECTION 1. 2-ACETYLNICOTINIC ACID.
- 4 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.29.02 of the Har-
- 5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 6 2-Acetylnicotinic acid) is amended by striking the date in
- 7 the effective period column and inserting "12/31/2011".
- 8 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 9 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
- 10 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 11 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
