Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION
1. 2-METHYL-4,6
BIS[(OCTYLTHIO)METHYL]PHENOL.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.32.14 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to 2-methyl-4,6-bis[(octylthio)methyl]phenol) is amended by
