#### **Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:**

The subject product is a synthetic organic chemical that is used as a herbicide safener for corn. Herbicide safeners improve the selectivity of herbicides between crops and weeds allowing for lower doses of herbicides to be used without reducing efficacy. The product is imported from Germany.
