The Commission staff notes that HTS heading 9902.02.07 had provided a temporary duty suspension for the subject product that expired on December 31, 2006. That heading should be used to renew the duty suspension. The article description on page 1 of this report should be used in heading 9902.02.07 to provide the proper chemical name.
