Technical comments:⁴

⁴ The Commission may express an opinion on the HTS classification of a product to facilitate consideration of the bill. However, by law, only the U.S. Customs Service is authorized to issue a binding ruling on this matter. The Commission believes that the U.S. Customs Service should be consulted prior to enactment of the bill.

The Commission staff recommends that the article description on page 1 of this report be used in the proposed new heading in order to use a lower case "p" in peroxydicarbonate, and to provide the correct HTS classification.
