#### **Technical comments:**<sup>5</sup>

The Commission staff notes that the HTS subheading reference that is contained in the article description of HTS heading 9902.03.61 is incorrect. The subject product is classified in HTS subheading 3204.12.50. The article description of HTS heading 9902.03.61 should be amended by deleting "3204.12.45" and inserting "3204.12.50".

The Commission may express an opinion on the HTS classification of a product to facilitate consideration of the bill. However, by law, only the U.S. Customs Service is authorized to issue a binding ruling on this matter. The Commission believes that the U.S. Customs Service should be consulted prior to enactment of the bill.

- 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.03.61 of the Har-
- 5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 6 acid black 107) is amended by striking "12/31/2006" and
- 7 inserting "12/31/2011".
- 8 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 9 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 10 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 11 the date of the enactment of this Act.
