Mixtures containing methyl 2-[(4,6-dimethoxypyrimidin-2-ylcarbamoyl)sulfamoyl]- α - (methanesulfonamido)-p-toluate (Mesosulfuron-methyl) (CAS No. 208465-21-8) and methyl 4-iodo-2-[3-(4-methoxy-6-methyl-1,3,5-triazin-2-yl)ureidosulfonyl]benzoate, sodium salt (Iodosulfuron methyl, sodium salt) (CAS No. 144550-36-7), whether or not mixed with application adjuvants (provided for in subheading 3808.93.15).

The subject mixture of synthetic organic chemicals is a post-emergent herbicide product for controlling annual ryegrass (or Italian ryegrass), wild oats, and other broadleaf weeds. The product is imported from Germany.
