Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:

The subject product is a synthetic organic chemical that is used as a fungicide for grapes, bananas, cereals, and other crops. This fungicide is effective in controlling powdery mildew on hops. The product is imported from Germany.

Technical comments:4

The Commission staff notes that there is an existing duty suspension for the subject product under HTS heading 9902.10.70 that expires on December 31, 2009. HTS heading 9902.10.70 should be used to extend the existing duty suspension. Also, the Commission staff recommends that the article description on page 1 of this report be used in HTS heading 9902.10.70 in order to correct the chemical name and include the common name "Spiroxamine".

⁴ The Commission may express an opinion on the HTS classification of a product to facilitate consideration of the bill. However, by law, only the U.S. Customs Service is authorized to issue a binding ruling on this matter. The Commission believes that the U.S. Customs Service should be consulted prior to enactment of the bill.
