- 3 SECTION 1. ALLYL ISOSULFOCYNATE.
- 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.01.41 of the Har-
- 5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 6 Allyl isosulfocynate) is amended by striking "12/31/2009"
- 7 and inserting "12/31/2011".
- 8 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 9 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 10 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 11 the date of the enactment of this Act.
