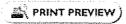

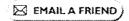

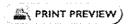
As the Director of Financial Management, Strategic Planning and Evaluation, you will be responsible for overseeing and directing financial management, strategic planning, budget and internal controls activities relating to the programs and operations of the agency, as well as program evaluation for the African Development Foundation ADF.

You will serve as a senior member of the ADF management team and report to the President of the Foundation; and serve as the principal financial advisor to the President of ADF with responsibility for ensuring: (a) all ADF budget coordination; (b) short and long range strategic planning; (c) program evaluations; (d) necessary controls are in place; and, (e) audit and Inspector General Audit/Investigation recommendations have compliance which includes:

- Exercising full supervisory and managerial skills over the Financial Management Division. Additionally, is responsible for strategic planning and developing policy for monitoring and evaluation, ADF; and providing expert budgetary, financial management and advisory services to the senior management of ADF for all aspects of ADF's financial management policies, programs, and systems (including: banking, budgeting, accounting, and revenue management).
- Establishing and maintaining an integrated and automated financial management system which encompasses a general ledger, managerial-financial reporting and produces financial statements.
- · Providing expert budgetary, financial management and advisory services to the senior management of the ADF and has responsibility for all aspects of ADF's financial management policies, programs and systems; and includes preparing the annual budget report, the Congressional Budget Justification, the Program Assessment Rating Tool, Performance Accountability Report, the President's Management Agenda; Annual Performance Goals and other initiatives.
- · Ensuring the Development of ADF's vision, mission statement, strategic mission statement, strategic plan and reports to the President and Chief Executive Officer, all milestones, achievements and any problems, issues that have resulted in not meeting elements of the plan.

 Exercising leadership and guidance and technical support in conducting self-monitoring and reporting on implementation of planned program activities and achievement of results; as well as, managing and/or developing an ADF monitoring and evaluation policy which includes managing and/or participating in developing and/or revising guidelines (including operational guidelines, procedures and related operational tools to assist the Monitoring and Evaluation Section in all aspects of ADF's work).

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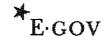

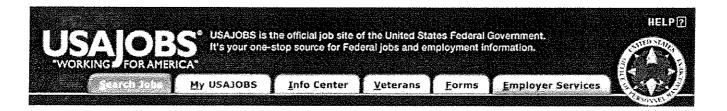

This type of work typically involves development and formulation and execution of the budget, serving as a key management advisor on diverse financial and/or budget issues; and/or development and implementation of financial management, budget, strategic planning policies, directives, regulations, and laws.

- 2.. Mastery knowledge and skill in formulating goals and/or objectives, priorities and implementing financial plans consistent with the long terms interests of the organization which includes capitalizing on opportunities and managing risks.
- 3. Demonstrated leadership and managerial expertise and skills which include applying analytic, diagnostic and qualitative techniques to identify, evaluate, and recommend appropriate solutions to complex interrelated financial management, strategic planning and monitoring and evaluation programs and budgetary problems and issues.
- 4. Demonstrated skill as a key management advisor in managing critical relationships for a

successful financial management program including presenting oral and written budgetary reports as well as exchanging information with the Office of Management and Budget, the U.S. Congress, financial management staff, and financial audit entities which includes planning strategically, analyzing programmatic initiatives, and reporting trends impacting mission objectives; and working cooperatively on a senior staff and managing competing priorities.

- 5. Expertise and skill managing multiple, high volume financial and accounting programs, conducting independent research, filtering and synthesizing data, and producing clear, logical and concise guidance, instructions, policies, procedures, and/or regulations.
