






### STD Budget Within CDC – Past/Present






## Estimated Incidence of STDs, US, 1996

**B** = Efficiency of transmission


**D** = Duration of infection




#### **Present Sexual Networks - 1**



### STDs – Present Diagnostic Approaches

- More accurate molecular focus
- More convenient urine-based
- Less expensive automated reading
- Rapid feedback on-site information

### STDs – Present Treatment Approaches

- More convenient single daily doses
- Fewer side effects broader acceptability
- Less expensive global availability
- More choices minimize resistance



### HIV – Therapeutic Issues

- HAART available/effective
- Adherence difficulties cumbersome
- Resistance concerns
- Unleashing unsafe behaviors
- Prevention implications viral load




#### **STD Prevention Strategies**

- Individual level
  - C avoid risky partners
  - B use condoms
  - D get tested
- Population level
  - C reduce population prevalence
  - **B** change social norms
  - D improve clinic services




### Estimated New Cases of Curable STDs\* Among Adults, 1999





#### NIH Condom Report: The Scientific Evidence

- Effectiveness against HIV, Gc, and pregnancy
- Data since 6/00 also support effect on Ct, HSV
- Main reason for ineffectiveness is NON-USE
- Thus, condom promotion campaigns needed



#### NIH Condom Report: Scientific/Political Questions

- Data inadequacies, especially HPV
- Misrepresentation of findings
- Focus on perfection obscures public health messages



# Condoms: The Take Home Messages

- Condoms ARE effective
- Correct, consistent use essential
- Reinforcement needed from multiple levels
- New condoms greater "pleasure"
