# Introduction

This booklet provides an overview of the Electronic System for Trademark Trials and Appeals (**ESTTA**). ESTTA allows parties to complete TTAB forms online and submit them electronically. ESTTA is a web application that is available to parties and the general public, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, except during system maintenance.

This is a quick reference guide to help you use ESTTA. For further details, please refer to the online help.

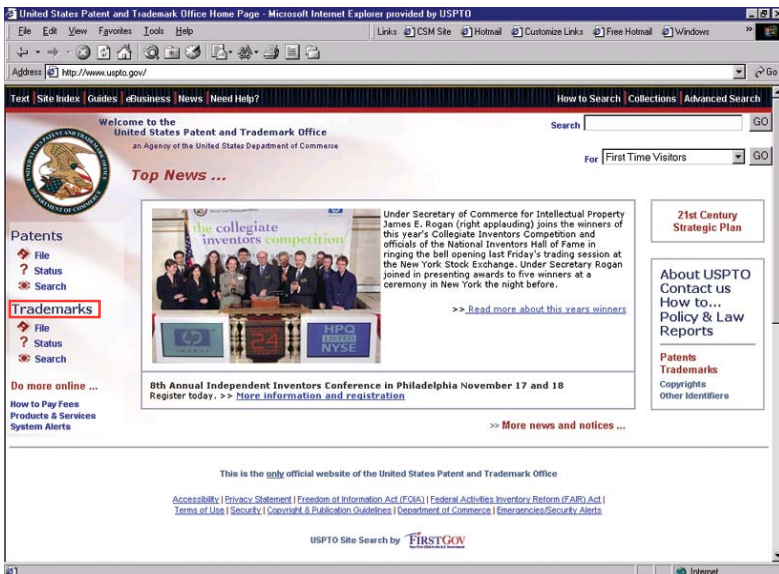

Failure to follow the instructions may cause you to fill out sections of the form incorrectly, jeopardizing your legal rights.

**Filing Date.** Eastern Time controls the filing date. Forms filed via ESTTA are time-stamped with the official filing date when received on the USPTO server, unless a fee is required, in which case the time stamp is applied when the payment process is completed and the receipt screen is displayed. The time the transmission began is not a factor considered when assigning the filing date. 


