SUBJECT: Online Ethics Training on Government Contractors

The Office of Government Ethics (OGE) has created an online course called "Working with Contractors: What You Need to Know." The course is an interactive web-based training module that is designed as an introduction to some of the most common ethics questions that Government employees might encounter when working with contractor employees. It particularly may be useful for Government employees who work closely with employees of Government contractors who are situated in a Government Facility.

This new course complements the "Interacting with Government Employees for Contractors" course that OGE published in June of this year. That earlier course is designed for contractor employees who work closely with Government officials. Both courses cover the same basic information, but each is geared to a different audience.
