FACT SHEET ON ACCESSING A PROACTIVE DISCLOSURE SERVICE PROTOTYPE (PDS) REPORT DISCLOSURE

The PDS

The PDS was developed in response to a growing interest in on-going monitoring of health care practitioners. Entities that subscribe to the PDS receive notification within one business day of the Data Banks' receipt of a report on their enrolled practitioners without having to perform a traditional query on the subjects.

This service is offered as an alternative to the current traditional Data Bank querying service. Entities may continue to query on practitioners, enroll all practitioners in the PDS, or enroll some practitioners in the PDS while continuing to use the traditional query method on others. The PDS meets the legal and accreditation requirements for querying the National Practitioner Data Bank (NPDB). As long as the practitioner remains enrolled in the PDS you have met the requirement to query. Enrollment confirmation may be used to demonstrate compliance with accreditation standards including on-going monitoring. The format and the information contained in the Data Bank report, as well as the information required to be reported to each Data Bank, remain the same.

Notification of a Report Disclosure

Entities with PDS-enrolled practitioners receive notification of all new or updated Data Bank reports within one business day of Data Bank receipt of the report. Notice is provided via e-mail and PDS notification via the Options screen in the IQRS. Entities must log in to the Integrated Querying and Reporting Service (IQRS) or use the Interface Control Document (ICD) Transfer Program (ITP) to retrieve reports.

Accessing a Report Disclosure

To access a report disclosure in the PDS:

- Log in to the IQRS, located at www.npdb-hipdb.hrsa.gov.
- On the Registration Confirmation screen, click Continue.
- 3. The *Options* screen displays notification of any unviewed report disclosures. On this screen, click **Proactive Disclosure Service.**

- On the *Proactive Disclosure Service* screen (Figure 1), click View Report Disclosures.




Figure 2. PDS Report Disclosures Screen

- On the *PDS Report Disclosures* screen (Figure 2), click a Report DCN link to view detailed information about the disclosure. Click the Subject link to view the PDS Subject Details screen, which displays enrollment information and includes all reports on this subject.

Report Disclosure Availability

A report disclosure is viewable as long as the report is

active and the report subject is enrolled in the PDS. Report disclosures are available in Portable Document Format (PDF).

Note: You may sort the disclosures by clicking on the column heading links. To view specific groups of disclosures, select filter criteria and click **Filter Results**.
