STUDY TO ESTABLISH CERTAIN CRITERIA FOR THE CLASSIFICATION OF VACUUM CLEANERS AS ELECTRO-MECHANICAL "DOMESTIC" APPLIANCES OF HEADING 85.09

I. SECRETARIAT COMMENTS

1. After the publication of Doc. NC0709E1, the Secretariat received the following comments from the Administration of Poland concerning the study to establish criteria for distinguishing between "domestic" vacuum cleaners of heading 85.09 and "industrial" vacuum cleaners of heading 84.79.

II. NOTE FROM THE ADMINISTRATION OF POLAND

- 2. "In connection with your letter of 10 December 2002 No. 02NL1031E J/id concerning the study to establish criteria for distinguishing between "domestic" vacuum cleaners of heading 85.09 and "industrial" vacuum cleaners of heading 84.79, the Polish Customs Administration would like to explain the following.
- 3. The Polish Customs Administration, during settlement of classification vacuum cleaners, mainly follows the wording of headings 85.09 and 84.79 and the Note 3 of Chapter 85 and HS Explanatory Notes to heading 85.09.
- 4. In determination of the classification of above mentioned appliances we conduct assessment of their characteristics on a case-by-case basis and at each time we estimate their destination and usefulness, since quoted texts does not specify the criteria for classification of vacuum cleaners for "domestic" and "industrial" purposes.
- 5. The bases for determination their destinations are mainly documents presented with imported appliances, like service manual, catalogues of appliances provided by manufacturers, importer explanations, moreover we check the classification in exporter documents, etc.
