AMENDMENTS TO THE COMPENDIUM OF CLASSIFICATION OPINIONS ARISING FROM THE CLASSIFICATION OF "POM-BÄR" IN SUBHEADING 1905.90 (Item VI.1 on Agenda)

I. BACKGROUND

- 1. At its 22nd Session (November 1998), the Harmonized System Committee examined the classification of "POM-BÄR Potato Snacks" having the following compositions: potato powder (about 31%), vegetable oil, starch, modified starch, salt, sugar, emulsifier (lecithin), yeast extract and spice, fried in oil and ready for consumption. The snacks, which are put up in a packing (plastic bag) for retail sale, are yellowish and in the shape of bears.
- 2. The Committee decided, by 12 votes to 6, to classify "POM-BÄR" in heading 19.05 rather than in heading 20.05.
- 3. To reflect this decision the Secretariat was instructed to prepare a draft Classification Opinion for examination by the next presessional Working Party. (Following the decision taken by the Harmonized System Committee at its 22nd session to classify "POM-BÄR Potato Snacks" in heading 19.05, the Swiss Administration entered a reservation against the decision. The Swiss Administration subsequently withdrew its reservation, and the Committee decided at its 23rd Session that the decision taken at its 22nd Session to classify "POM-BÄR Potato Snacks" in heading 19.05 should be taken as deemed approved by the Council. See paragraphs 14 to 17 of Doc. NC0090E2 (HSC/23/May 99)).

II. <u>SECRETARIAT COMMENTS</u>

- 4. Although the Committee did not decide on the classification at subheading level, the Secretariat is of the view that the snack food in question should be classified in subheading 1905.90. The Secretariat has therefore prepared a draft Classification Opinion for this subheading. Pending the Committee's decision on this subheading classification, the subheading references are retained in square brackets.
- 5. The draft Classification Opinion is set out in the Annex to this document.

III. CONCLUSION

6. The Committee is invited to approve the proposed text to amend the Compendium of Classification Opinions set out in the Annex once it has been finalized by the presessional Working Party.
