INTERNATIONAL & FOREIGN FUGITIVE ARRESTS OPERATION FALCON III

FALCON III, as with the previous operations, involved the pursuit and apprehension of fugitives beyond the borders of the United States. In addition, investigators located gang fugitives and sexual predators wanted by foreign law enforcement, but who eluded justice by hiding in this country. Through firmly established relationships, the USMS was able to share fugitive information with those foreign countries through the USMS Foreign Field Offices, INTERPOL, and other federal partners overseas, including the network of State Department Regional Security Officers stationed at every American Embassy throughout the world.
