POSSIBLE AMENDMENT OF HEADING 85.28 TO PROVIDE SEPARATELY FOR SATELLITE TELEVISION RECEIVERS (PROPOSAL BY THE EGYPTIAN ADMINISTRATION)

I. BACKGROUND

1. At its 25th Session, the Review Sub-Committee discussed possible amendments to heading 85.28 to insert a new provision for satellite television receivers while, at the same time, continuing to provide for black and white televisions. The US Delegate made a proposal from the floor for four two-dash subheadings under the one-dash subheading 8528.1. At the conclusion of its discussions, the Sub-Committee decided to return to this matter at its next session, on the basis of a new written proposal by the US Administration, which would be based on Alternative (1) in the proposal put forward by the Secretariat in the Annex to Doc. NR0223E1, but would also take into account the Sub-Committee's discussions. On 10 July 2002, the Secretariat received the following note from the US Administration.

II. US PROPOSAL FOR HEADING 85.28

- 2. "During its 25th Session, the Sub-Committee discussed possible modifications to heading 85.28. Among the issues discussed was how to arrange the subheadings in order to continue providing for black-and-white televisions and to add a new provision for satellite receivers. This administration offered a text from the floor, and agreed to try to develop a modified text that would incorporate our own proposal and the Secretariat's Alternative 1 (Annex to Doc. NR0223E1), for which support appeared to be emerging.
- 3. We offer the following text, which provides a clear distinction between products known in the trade as "televisions" (proposed subheadings 8528.11 and 8528.15) and products that are tuners without a display (proposed subheadings 8528.17 and 8528.19).
 - 85.28 Reception apparatus for television, whether or not incorporating radiobroadcast receivers or sound or video recording or reproducing apparatus; video monitors and video projectors.
 - Reception apparatus for television, whether or not incorporating radio-broadcast receivers or sound or video recording or reproducing apparatus:
 - 8528.11 -- Apparatus incorporating, or designed to incorporate, a colour video display
 - 8528.15 -- Apparatus incorporating, or designed to incorporate, a black and white or other monochrome video display
 - 8528.17 -- Satellite receivers, not incorporating, or designed to incorporate, a video display
 - 8528.19 -- Other
 - Video monitors:
 - 8528.21 -- Colour
 - 8528.22 -- Black and white or other monochrome
 - 8528.30 Video projectors".

III. SECRETARIAT COMMENTS

4. Due to its recent arrival, the Secretariat has reproduced the **US** note without comment. However, it would like to draw the Sub-Committee's attention to Agenda Item III.B.5 (**EC** proposal to amend Chapters 84, 85, 90 and 95), which also covers current heading 85.28.

IV. CONCLUSION

5. The Sub-Committee is invited to take account of the US proposal when it examines this agenda item.
