ABILENE, Kan. - The Eisenhower Presidential Library and Museum opens its doors for the annual holiday reception on Dec. 7 from 2 to 4 p.m.at the Visitors Center Auditorium. The reception is free of charge and open to the public. Free admission to the museum will be offered throughout the day and the gift shop will be offering a special 10% discount all day for holiday shoppers.

The program will begin with a recognition of all the volunteers who generously donate their time at the Eisenhower Presidential Library. Included in the volunteer recognition will be a re-presenting of the National Archives "Weidman Outstanding Volunteer Service Award" to Elinor Wiley Haas. The award will officially be given to Haas at a public ceremony in D.C. on Dec. 4.

In honor of Pearl Harbor Day, a short 4-minute video clip showing the attack of Pearl Harbor will be played followed by a moment of silence in remembrance. The video clip will be shown before the orientation film for visitors throughout the morning.

The Eisenhower Presidential Library is once again pleased to welcome the Abilene Municipal Band for their holiday concert. To add to the holiday spirit, the center has decorated for the season. A holiday village is on display in the Visitors Center Auditorium and a 15' tree had been decorated in the Library lobby.
