




General map of VACO, VAMC and George Washington University Medical Center

Decontamination in Washington D.C. for Chemical, Biological and Nuclear Agents



The VA Medical Center Washington, DC, and George Washington University Medical Center have established a plan of action for responding to a potential biological, chemical or nuclear terrorist attack. In addition to prompt recognition of the incident and efficient medical treatment, the medical facilities have a well-developed plan for decontamination of exposed citizens.

This brochure provides directions to these two facilities in the event VA employees are potentially exposed to toxic agents. The aim of decontamination is to rapidly and effectively remove toxic substances from the body. Decontamination is a critical factor that may reduce the toxic effects of exposure. The most effective initial step in personal protection is to remove contaminated clothing.


Walking Directions
