Resolution of the Florida Keys National Marine Sanctuary Advisory Council October 16, 2007

The Florida Keys National Marine Sanctuary (FKNMS) Advisory Council supports all efforts being undertaken by Miami-Dade County Department of Environmental Resources Management to reduce pollution, including nutrient loading, impacts to seagrasses and benthic communities, debris impacts, and impacts to endangered species, to the waters of Florida Bay and the Florida Keys National Marine Sanctuary originating along the Card Sound Road corridor.

The FKNMS Advisory Council further recommends that Monroe County re-establish the Monroe County Department of Marine Resources to support this effort.
