

Example of Creating a Search Button From Your Website

By adding a Grants.gov search button to their website, agencies can allow customers to download a Grants.gov application with a single click. Rather than leaving an agency's site to visit Grants.gov and search for a particular grant opportunity, applicants can be taken directly to the right download page.
