
Drinking Diary Card and Change Plan

Depending on your facility, order via your Forms and Publications Control Officers or Supply/Warehouse staff who have access to "FPOrders," the automated ordering system for the Service and Distribution Center (SDC) at Hines. From EES (order numbers begin with "F"):

With the VA Learning University (VALU) and Employee Education System (EES) product ordering system, all VA employees can order products and have them shipped directly to the individual who requested it or to themselves. As a user, all you have to do is:
