

Purpose:

- 3. Monitor and report legislative, executive and judicial changes in laws, regulations and implementation directives affecting international transactions.
- 4. Recommend policies and procedures that facilitate international transactions and minimize adverse programmatic impacts.
- 5. Serve as a resource for evaluation.
