Sensitive Property List Los Alamos National Laboratory

Definition

Sensitive property

- Is easily converted to personal use or sold for cash.
- Is susceptible to theft.
- Is not expended during use or incorporated within other property

Acquisition Cost Threshold

Property costing \$300 or more will be controlled, with the exception of hand-held computers and firearms, which are considered sensitive property regardless of acquisition cost.

Description	Comments
Still & Digital Cameras	Except disposable, Polaroid, close-up, oscilloscope, x-ray, surveillance, and Charge Coupled Device (CDC) cameras.
Firearms	No minimum acquisition cost.
Personal Computers	Includes desktop, server, laptop, and notebook.
Hand-held computers (e.g. PDAs or organizers with PC connectivity)	No minimum acquisition cost.

Printers	Laser, ink-jet style & multifunctional.
Radios, two-way	
Recorders	Video, tape, video cassette (VCR), dictation machines, digital, compact disc (CD), digital virtual disc (DVD), and digital.

Video Cameras	TV, movie & video.
