

### Document of the Month 1906 San Francisco Earthquake and Fire: The Freeman Report



ieutenant Frederick N. Freeman, stationed at the nearby Mare Island **└─Naval Shipyard in Vallejo,** California, deserves acclamation as a "Real Hero" of the catastrophic 1906 San Francisco Earthquake and Fire. The firefighting work of Freeman and his crew, hard at work without sleep for three crucial days of the 1906 earthquake and fire, had special significance because the earthquake had destroyed San Francisco's municipal water supply; furthermore, San Francisco firefighters and police were largely unavailable on the waterfront.

Lieutenant Freeman's lively, and informative report of his activities and observations during the 1906 rescue effort, submitted on April 30, 1906, has survived. Soon after its discovery as a "classified document" in 1972 among the holdings of the National Archives Pacific Region-San Francisco, it was declassified and made available to historians and the public as a major historical primary source concerning the 1906 Earthquake and Fire.
