# Significant Offshore Damage from 2 Hurricanes

- 111 platforms destroyed
- 65 from Rita- 32 more with ext. damage
- 46 from Katrina 20 ext. damage
- -(7 from Ivan- 20 w/ext.damage)
- 19 rigs adrift
- -13 from Rita
- -6 from Katrina (5 from Ivan)

# Other Damage

- Rigs extensive damage
- Rita- 7 jackups ; 2 semi; 0 platform
- Katrina- 2 jackups; 5 semi; 2 platform
- Rigs destroyed
- Rita- 1 jackup
- Katrina- 3 platforms, 1 jackup

# Pipeline Damage

- Back to back hurricanes have caused delay in assessment
- Many unknowns still (large production shut in)
- To date— 44 pipelines damaged (23 Rita)

## Production Shut –In

- Large amount of production remains shutin
- Wednesday Oct. 5 numbers were 86.6 percent of the oil and 68.9 percent of the natural gas

## MMS DAMAGE

- Hurricane Katrina Main building in New Orleans (1201) Elmwood was damaged and 600 employees displaced. Also N.O. District Office was closed
- Hurricane Rita MMS District
   Office in Lake Charles was
   damaged.

## Return of MMS

- N.O. District is open
- 150 employees planned for ABS Building, in Houston 16855 Northchase Dr.
- office is functional- 90 employees have arrived
- operations people /pipelines/ structures/plans
- environmental review
- unitization/SOO/SOP
- bonding/OSFR

#### Return – continued

- About 400 employees will return to 1201 Elmwood and area October 28 to resume operations
- So by October 28 almost all of Gulf Region will be back somewhere
- Who will remain in Houston—Regional Director, Operations (heavy), PD (heavy)
- Lk. Charles District handled out of Lafayette

## MMS - NTL's Issued

- NTL 2005-G12 issued announcing continuation of operations— who to call, what e-mail to send to
- NTL 2005-G17 on District operations
- NTL 2005-G16 on damage assessment for hurricane Katrina

# MMS Approvals During Hurricane Recovery- as of October 5

- 49 approvals to flare gas have been granted
- 36 pipeline repair, change of service, reroutings etc. have been granted
- 37 new surface commingling of production approvals have been granted
