Livestock Grazing

- Livestock grazing on the Comanche NG helps to promote a shifting mosaic of heterogeneous plant communities and structural stages across the landscape. The Timpas Grazing District has 23 allotments with 20 grazing district members.
- Livestock grazing provides 26,494 animal months for a grazing value of \$50,338.60 (2005 value). Of this amount, 75% is spent on range improvements (fences, water developments, wildlife habitat improvements) and administrative costs.
- Livestock grazing costs support the local economy and help maintain a traditional lifestyle in the area.
