- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Bristol Bay Protection
- 5 Act".

4	Section 8 of the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act

9	"(1) In general.—Notwithstanding any other
10	provision of this Act or any other law and except as
11	provided in paragraph (2), beginning on the date of
12	enactment of this subsection, the conduct of oil and
13	gas preleasing, leasing, and related activities is pro-
14	hibited in areas of the outer Continental Shelf lo-
15	cated in the North Aleutian Basin Planning Area.
16	"(2) Effect.—Nothing in this subsection af-
17	fects any rights under leases issued under this Act
18	before the date of enactment of this subsection.".
19	SEC. 3. EXCLUSION FROM COMPREHENSIVE INVENTORY OF
20	OUTER CONTINENTAL SHELF OIL AND NAT-
21	URAL GAS RESOURCES.
22	Section 357(a) of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 (42
23	U.S.C. 15912(a)) is amended by inserting after "Conti-
24	nental Shelf" the following: "(other than the North Aleu-

- 2 of the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act)".
