OCCUPANCY AND USE REGULATIONS

Pike National Forest

Pursuant to Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 261.50(a), the following acts are <u>prohibited</u> in the area described below and shown on the attached map, to promote public safety and reduce litter accumulation within Designated Shooting Areas on the Pike National Forest.

AREA COVERED BY THIS ORDER;

National Forest Designated Shooting Areas commonly known as the South Rampart Shooting Range, (T.13S., R.67W., Section 29, 6th P.M.), and the St. Peters Dome Shooting Range, (T.15S., R.67W. Section 17, 6th P.M.), as shown on the map accompanying this order.

THIS ORDER PROHIBITS;

- 1. Being in the area after sundown or before sunrise. 36 CFR 261.58 (1).
- Possessing a beverage which is defined as an alcoholic beverage by Colorado State Law. 36 CFR 261.58 (bb).

3. Discharging a firearm, air rifle or gas gun other than at cardboard targets, paper targets or manufactured clay type throw targets. 36 CFR 261.58(m).

EXEMPTIONS:

.

The following persons are exempt from the prohibitions contained in this order:

- Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. <u>36 CFR 261.50</u> (e) (4).
- 2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission. 36 CFR 261.50 (e) (1).
