Old Grade Campground is located on the scenic Little Manistee River. This campground is completely surrounded by National Forest land. The pristine area offers opportunities to view a variety of wildlife including deer, beaver, and many songbirds. It provides an excellent opportunity for the quiet enjoyment of the woods and water. There is a short hiking trail which offers exploration of a hemlock and birch forest habitat.

LOCATION

Old Grade Campground is located in Lake County, Michigan. The nearest community is Baldwin, Michigan, about 11 miles south.

NATIONAL FOREST ACCESS

From Junction Highway M-55 and M-37: Travel south about 11 miles then right at the entrance to Old Grade Campground. There is a highway sign for the campground.

From Baldwin: Travel north on M-37 about 11 miles then turn left at the entrance to Old Grade Campground. There is a highway sign for the campground.

FACILITIES AVAILABLE

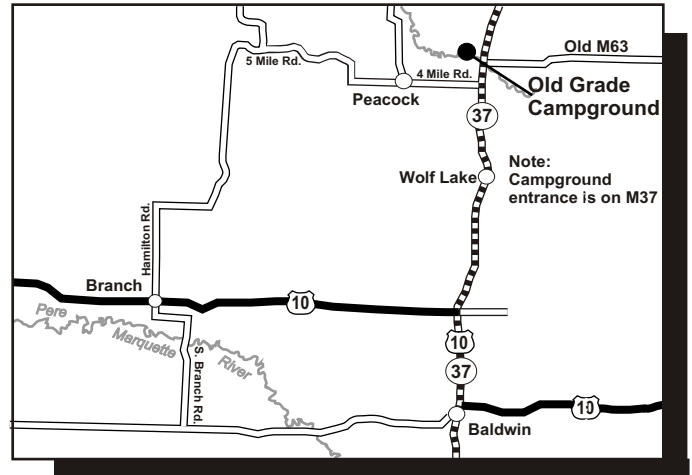
- 20 Paved campsite spurs

SEASON

The camping season is from Memorial Day through Labor Day weekend. There are no reservations taken (occupancy is on a first come, first serve basis). Please contact the Baldwin Ranger Station regarding dates outside the managed season (231-745-4631).

FEES

The campground is operated by a concessionaire under a special-use permit. Campsites are first come, first serve. Campsites accommodate up to 8 people and 2 vehicles. For additional information

CONSIDERATIONS

There is no electricity or showers at this site.

Please collect only dead and down wood for your campfire. It is illegal to cut live trees.

There is a campground host who resides in the campground during the camping season.

The segment of the river adjoining the campground is shallow. Canoeing is not recommended.
