Dorner Lake Campground offers a scenic, rustic experience on the shores of Dorner Lake. This beautiful lake is a popular pan fishing lake and provides excellent fishing and boating opportunities.

LOCATION

Dorner Lake Campground is located in Manistee County, Michigan. The nearest community is Wellston, about 2 miles northwest.

ACCESS

From the west, take M-55 east 2 miles from its junction with County Road 669 (Bosschem Road) in Wellston, then turn right on Snyder Road for about 1.5 miles to the site.

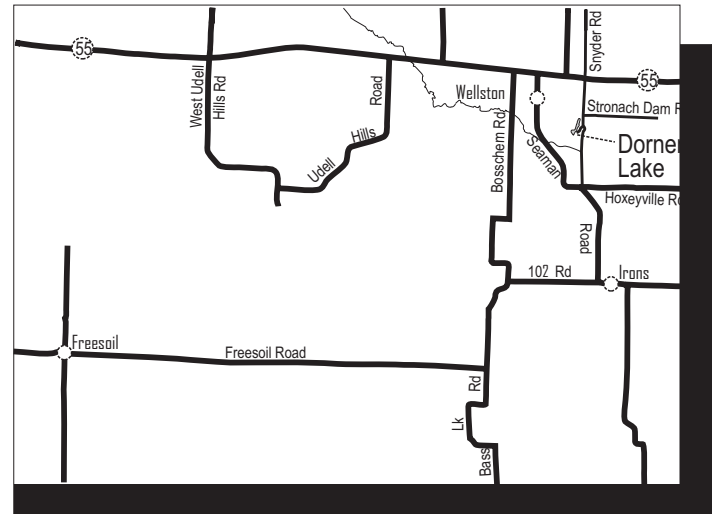
From the east, take M-55 west 6.5 miles from its junction with M-37, then left on Snyder Road for about 1.5 miles to the site.

SEASON

The season is from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day. However, the area is open year around, unless closed by snowfall. Please check with the Manistee Ranger Station regarding dates outside the summer season.



FEES

For the latest information regarding fees and condition of the facility, contact the Manistee Ranger Station. No reservations may be made for the campsites. There is a \$3 day use fee that the National Forests Pass program does not cover.
