Mack Lake Campground provides access to some of the best Off Road Vehicle Trails in Michigan. The lake is surrounded by rolling jack pine plains, which provide nesting habitat for the endangered Kirtland's Warbler. The campground is scenic and secluded. Because the lake is so shallow, fishing is marginal.

LOCATION

This campground is located in Oscoda County, Michigan. The nearest community is Mio, about 8.5 miles northwest.

ACCESS

From the north, leave M-33 at a point about 4 miles south of Mio. Turn east onto County Road 489 and follow approximately 4 miles to the site entrance.

From the south, leave M-33 at a point about 10 miles north of Rose City. Turn east onto County Road 604 and follow 4 miles. Turn left on Forest Service Road 4460 (Fowler Road) for 1 mile. Go left approximately 1 mile on county road 489 to the site entrance.

Day use area:



The season is from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day. Please check with the Mio Ranger Station at 989-826-3252 regarding information on the Concessionaire and dates outside the managed season.
