

This large trail camp is one of several campgrounds on the Shore-to-Shore trail. Used primarily by horseback riders, the camp is available throughout the year for hunting, backpacking, biking, and general camping. The campground can easily accommodate large groups.

# LOCATION

The McKinley Trail Camp is located in Oscoda County, Michigan. The nearest community is Mio, about 9 miles west.

### ACCESS

From Mio, take county Road 602 east 9 miles to the McKinley Trail Camp access road (Forest Service Road 4004). Turn north and travel 1 mile to the camp.


From Glennie, take Bamfield Road west 4 miles, turn north on Au Sable River Road about 7 miles. Turn left on Road F-32 for 6 miles, then south on Forest Road 4144 for about 1 mile and west on county Road 602 for 2 miles to the McKinley Trail Camp access road (Forest Service Road 4004).

# SEASON

The season is from May 20 through October 31. However, the area may be used at any time throughout the year. The road into the trail camp is not plowed and water is not provided after October 31. Please check with the Mio Ranger Station regarding access and water outside the managed season (989-826-3252).
