## LOCATION

This campground is located in Oscoda County, Michigan. The nearest community is Luzerne, about 6.5 miles northeast.

## ACCESS

Take County Road 490 south from Luzerne, turn left on Durfee Road, turn right on Forest Road 4556 into the campground.

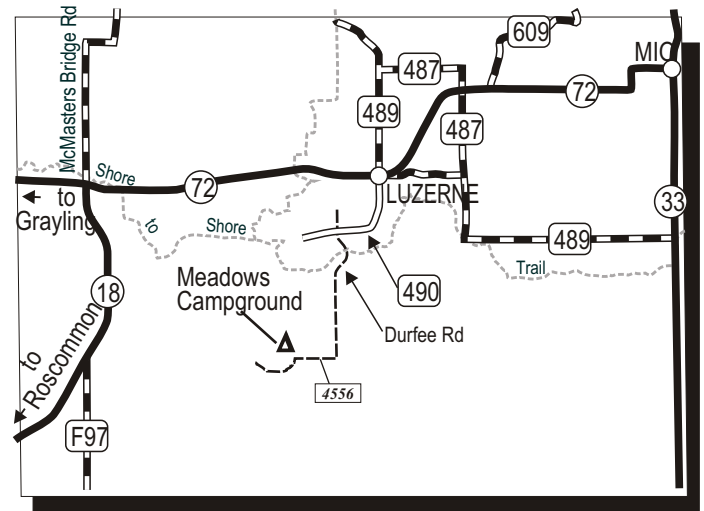
## FACILITIES AVAILABLE

- 16 camping spurs with fire rings
- 2 Vault toilet buildings
- 1 Hand pump
- ORV trail access
- Nearby Fishing

All ORV's must meet all state regulations for noise emissions and have a current ORV license displayed. USDA-Forest Service approved spark arresters are required to ride Forest trails. Ride **ONLY** on designated trails, and do not ride beyond your abilities.

## SEASON

The campground is open year round. The road is **NOT** plowed in the winter. Water is not available during freezing temperatures.



## FEES

The Huron-Manistee National Forest Recreation Fee is required at this site. Please contact the MIO Ranger Station at 989-826-3252 for complete details and costs.

## CONSIDERATIONS

Care should be taken to keep the area clean and in the condition it was found. Please pack out what you pack in.

Motorcycles and quadcycles should also be parked on the campsite spurs.
