Rollways Campground is a small, secluded campground located along the beautiful AuSable River. The campground offers pull-through style camping sites and is an excellent camping area for the nature lover. Access to the river from the campground is very steep and difficult. Boating and fishing access to Loud Pond is available six miles east along M-65 to Loud Dam Pond and the Loud Dam boat launch. Rollways has two decks, picnic grounds and a log shelter. Rollways picnic area is part of the Recreation Fee Demonstration Project and a vehicle pass is required there.

## LOCATION

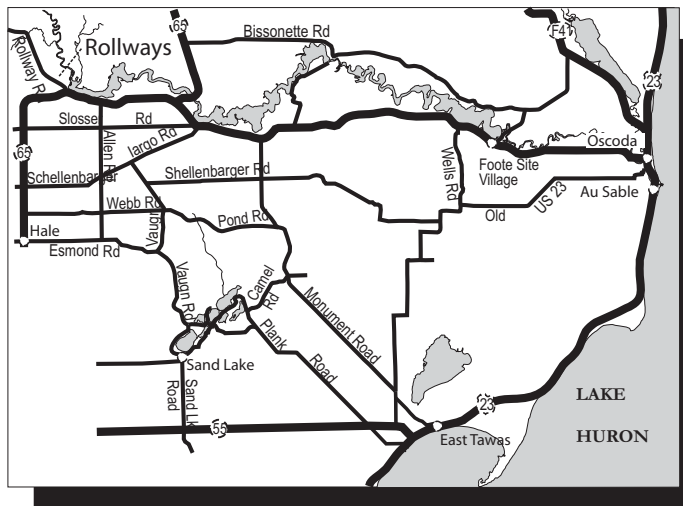
Rollways Campground is located in Iosco County, Michigan. The nearest community is Hale, about 7 miles south.

## ACCESS

From the south, follow M-65 north from its junction with M-55 about 14 miles to Rollway Road. Then turn north for 0.1 mile to the entrance on the right.
