RECREATION FEE DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM Vehicle Passes

All Forest Service access sites on the Pere Marquette River, require a Recreation Fee Demonstration (RFD) Vehicle Pass. RFD passes may be purchased at local vendors, liveries, and Forest Service Offices. They cost \$3.00 per day, \$5.00 per week, and \$20.00 annually. A Household pass costs \$30.00, and includes 2 annual passes. RFD funds support local access sites and programs.
