MEMORANDUM FOR CAP REGION AND WING COMMANDERS

SUBJECT: Change to Civil Air Patrol (CAP) Calendar Month Oil Change Requirements

- 1. CAP aircraft calendar month oil change requirements listed in CAP Regulation 66-1 (CAPR 66-1) paragraph 9a3) have been changed from 4 to 6 months. New text will read "Oil changes shall not exceed 6 calendar months for both systems listed under paragraphs 9a1) and 9a2)." The oil change must be accomplished on or prior to the last day of the sixth calendar month.
- 2. Wing maintenance officers will ensure that aircraft oil and filter changes are accomplished and engine logbooks are annotated in accordance with the schedule published in CAPR 66-1 and this policy letter.
