Temporary Traffic Delays on Feather Falls Access Road

Fire closures have been lifted, however, there will be temporary traffic delays on the access road to Feather Falls for at least two weeks, beginning on September 30. A pilot car will escort traffic Monday through Friday, but visitors should expect delays of up to one hour or more. The area will be open to traffic on weekends, with no delays. Improvements include road and parking lot resurfacing.

Roadside hazard tree reduction operations continue with felling and logging truck activity along the Hartman Bar Road. Travelers should use caution and proceed at a low rate of speed. Logging in the area is slated to last through mid-October.
