2.	What reading rooms have "chat"? Hint: Chat is available through the same form that allows patrons to "Ask a Librarian"
3.	Where can you find information about "professional development" programs for educators? Hint: Go to Resources forTeachers > The Learning Page > Professional Development
4.	Find a photograph of the Fort Worth Livestock Exchange. In which collection did you find it?
5.	Locate an interesting motion picture. Hint: "Browse" (top) or "More browse options" (bottom) American Memory to identify collections containing motion pictures
6.	Locate a map of Dallas or Fort Worth. Hint: "Browse" (top) or "More browse options" (bottom) American Memory to limit search to collections containing maps
7.	Use three different browse options available after clicking "More Browse Options" to locate collections might offer materials for a topic you teach. Which browse option was most useful and why? Hint: American Memory > More Browse options > choose from topics, formats, time period or location

8.	Find two <i>Collection Connections</i> that interest you and have teaching resources. How might these resources be useful to you? Hint: Collection Connections are linked from the bottom of the home page of individual American Memory collections; locate American Memory collections of interest by using "More Browse options"
9.	What is one of the LoC's <b>Top Treasures</b> ? Hint: Go to <b>Exhibitions</b> from the LoC main page > American Treasures > Top Treasures.
10.	Identify one exhibition of interest that is not currently on display. Hint: Past exhibitions are listed alphabetically by title.
11.	Where can you learn how to bookmark an item you found when searching in the American Memory collections? Hint: Go to American Memory > Help > FAQ > Bookmarking, Linking
12.	Name two educational resources from "More Educational Resources – Around and Beyond the Library" that you might share with a colleague in another discipline. Hint: Go to Resources forTeachers > The Learning Page
13.	Find 2 pieces of sheet music that relate to World War I. Hint: "Browse" American Memory to identify collections containing sheet music > Identify the collection(s) covering the correct time period > Browse the subject index
14.	Locate a baseball card from Texas. Hint: "Browse" American Memory to identify collections related to sports > Search those with baseball cards
