Recreation.gov is now the place to reserve campgrounds for all federal recreation reservations. The toll free number *1-877-444-6777* is still active for telephone reservations.

Those sites on the Grand Mesa, Uncompahgre and Gunnison National Forests that permit reservations are:

We also have new Interagency Passes available in 2007. The Interagency Passes include the Senior Pass, Access Pass, Annual Pass and Volunteer Pass.





Two new passes will be available and honored on the GMUG NF beginning in 2007. The Interagency Senior Pass and the Interagency Access Pass.

The Senior Pass replaces the Golden Age Passport. This pass is for those who are 62 years of age or older. The pass is \$10.00 each and has a lifetime benefit to the holder. To purchase a Senior Pass, you will need to show an ID and proof that you are a citizen or permanent resident of the United States. The Golden Age Passport pass will continue

to be honored. The Senior and Golden Age provides a 50% discount on use fees such as camping and boat launch fees.





The Access Pass replaces the Golden Access Passport. This pass is free to individuals with permanent disabilities and has a lifetime benefit to the holder. To receive a pass, you will need to provide proof of your disability, documentation from the Social Security Department of blindness or permanent disability. The Golden Access Passport will continue to be honored. The Access and Golden Access Passes provide a 50% discount on use fees such as camping and boat launch fees.

These passes will be honored at:

Forest Service Campgrounds National Parks Monuments Bureau of Land management Bureau of Reclamation US Fish & Wildlife Service Sites





The Annual Pass replaces the Golden Eagle Passport. The Golden Eagle Passport was not honored on National Forest System lands. The new Annual Pass will be honored only at 3 camping pods (*Angel Creek, Thistledown and Atlas*) in the *Canyon Creek* area on the Ouray Ranger District. The Annual Pass sells for \$80 and is valid for one year.
