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

HURRICANE DAMAGED TRAILER PARK WITH OVERFLOWING LIFT STATION BEHIND BUILDINGS






UTILITY OWNER MENTAL MODELS

BEHAVIOR OVER TIME-QUICK FIXES ARE NOT WORKING









SHIFTING THE BURDEN

- Promote mutual aid agreements among local and regional utilities
- Improve cooperation between utilities to work on long term solutions
- F Educate utilities on the health issues
- Work with utilities to purchase needed generators and pump trucks
