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17. DESCRIBE IN SEQUENCE HOW ACCIDENT HAPPENED:

The drill crew was in the process of installing chicksan lines on the Expro Flowhead. The flowhead contains valves with handles that are held in place by safety pins. The crew was unaware that at some point after installation, the safety pin that secured the master valve handle fell out/was removed. While in the process of relocating one of the tugger lines, personnel tried to whip the line to get it on the other side of the valve and knocked the valve handle off. The valve handle weighing 23 pounds fell 49 feet and struck a Noble employee on the side of his hard hat. The employee sustained lacerations around the right eye and on the back and top of his head. Also, his wrist was broken.
