## 17. DESCRIBE IN SEQUENCE HOW ACCIDENT HAPPENED:

Two contractor employees were assisting in the removal of a section of heliport skirting in order to gain access to the top of the christmas tree below to install a lubricator. When the section of skirting was pulled free and lifted by the crane, one of the employees lost his footing and fell through the opening. He fell approximately 23' to the grating deck below, striking the wellhead on the way down.

No fall protection. Unsafe positions of personnel. Failure to provide barriers around open hole. No JSA was was prepared.
