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17. DESCRIBE IN SEQUENCE HOW ACCIDENT HAPPENED:

On February 10, 2007, welding/cutting operations were being conducted directly above open grating. Slag fell to the lower deck, igniting a bucket containing rags and rope.

On February 11, 2007, welding/cutting operations were being conducted directly above open grating. Slag fell to the lower deck, igniting polyflow tubing by the production separators.

18. LIST THE PROBABLE CAUSE(S) OF ACCIDENT:

Hot work operations were being conducted over open grating with insufficient insulation to keep slag from falling into the production separator area. Simultaneous production operations were being conducted at the time of both of the fires. Hot work was being conducted within ten (10) feet of active production lines.

19. LIST THE CONTRIBUTING CAUSE(S) OF ACCIDENT:

There was no production supervision on the platform (Fairways or contractor. Grasso Production is the contractor. Production personnel were not involved with Hot Work Permits or Job Safety Analysis (JSA). The only supervisor was a contruction superintendent who stated that he was only in charge of the construction work being conducted.
