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#### 17. DESCRIBE IN SEQUENCE HOW ACCIDENT HAPPENED:

On September 26, 2007, at approximately 19:25, at Arena Offshore, LLC's OCS-G 12989, Grand Isle (GI) 78 A Platform, a rigger was injured when a hydraulic hose struck him across his safety glasses, scraping his nose and cutting his left eyelid while changing out two hydraulic hoses on a crane, as a result of human error. Injured Person (IP) initially received first aid after the incident and then was sent onshore to seek medical treatment on September 27, 2007. IP was treated by ENT Physician on September 28, 2007 and October 05, 2007, and was released to return to work.

### Sequence of Events:

While changing out two hydraulic hoses on crane, the mechanic was pulling on one while rigger was guiding it out. It came out and hit the rigger across his safety glasses; scraping his nose and left a small cut on left eyelid. Provided first aid and let him rest for evening. Later he complained of headache and further evaluation indicated he may have broken his nose. IP was sent onshore for medical treatment. Injured party was treated by ENT Physician from 09-28-07 and 10-05-07, and released to return to work.
