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17. DESCRIBE IN SEQUENCE HOW ACCIDENT HAPPENED:

On October 24, 2007, at approximately 18:15, on ATP Oil & Gas's OCS-G 14016, Mississippi Canyon (MC) 711 A Platform (GOMEZ), a contract employee was injured when his middle finger tip on his left hand was pierced by a broken drill bit, as a result of equipment failure. Injured person (IP) was placed on light duty.

Sequence of Events:

A contract employee with Omega was drilling through a piece of metal when the drill bit in the drill broke. The piece of drill bit that was still in the drill pierced through his finger tip on this middle finger on the left hand. IP saw the medic to stop the bleeding and was sent to shore on October 25, 2007, for an evaluation at CECHE Occupational Medical Clinic in New Iberia, LA. IP had a clean puncture through his finger, missing the bone and there were no signs of foreign particles on the X-ray. IP was sent to light duty at Omega's yard.
