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On January 9, 2007, a 880 yard wide by 3 miles long sheen was observed at Grand Isle (GI) Block 47 and is beleived to be coming from the containment caisson at the toppled GI 47 C AUX platform. Due to weather conditions, BP has been unable to pump off the caisson since December 31, 2007. An estimated 2.47 bbls of oil has been released into Gulf waters.

Immediate Action Taken: The Seahorse VI is on location and deployed an absorbent boom for skimming operations.

Corrective Actions: Seas should be subsiding by this evening which will allow for pumping operations to take place.
