17. DESCRIBE IN SEQUENCE HOW ACCIDENT HAPPENED:

On February 21, 2008, at approximately 1210, on board the Transocean's Marianas drilling rig, located at BP E&P Inc.'s Lease OCS-G 8823, Mississippi Canyon Block 522, a Roustabout cut his left hand on expanded metal that was stacked on a work bench as he walked past it. Injured person (IP) was evacuated for evaluation and treatment. IP was placed on restricted duty.

Sequence of events:

Rig Employee Injured Hand on the Marianas Rig: Cut to left hand with expanded metal near alternative walkway.

Event Description: On February 21, 2008 at 1210 a Roustabout (IP) received a cut between his thumb and #1 finger while on his way to fill the MI Swaco equipment with diesel on the upper casing deck. The IP was walking towards the stairs behind the safe welding area alongside the expanded metal on the work bench. As the IP walked past two saw horses with expanded metal stacked on top of them near the walkway leading to the stairs, the IP's gloved left hand hit the corner of the stack of expanded metal and pulled his gloved hand into the sharp edge where it was lacerated. The laceration was on the back side of his hand between his index finger and thumb. The IP was then evaluated by the Transocean medic on board the Marianas. After the medic's evaluation the IP was recommended to be sent in on a regular scheduled helicopter for further treatment and evaluation by Transocean's company physician.
